An Early Intervention Math Program for Grade 1 and 2 Students

Number Sense is an early intervention program for Grade 1 and 2 students who are struggling with math fundamentals. The Number Sense Program uses play-based activities to reinforce counting, adding, subtracting, grouping and estimation skills. These skills are fundamental for math mastery.

Who should attend?

Students entering Grade 1 or 2:

- who find math very difficult
- whose teachers believe they could benefit from the support
- who are struggling with understanding basic math concepts
- whose parents perceive that their child has delays in math
