Jeu de mots is a play based early literacy program for Grade 1 and 2 French Immersion students to help build foundational reading skills in French. Conducted in French and held once weekly for 8-one hour sessions, *Jeu de mots* uses games, stories, songs and fun to build French vocabulary and important foundational reading skills.
